Dry'n Rocky Mix    \$7.00/oz \$73.00/lb A very showy combination; ideal for dry, rocky areas including sites with little to no topsoil, such as dams, road cuts, and construction sites. To make a site drier, scrape off 3"-6" of topsoil; this will also remove many competing weed seeds.	<i>Aromatic Aster, Purple Beardtongue, Black-eyed Susan, Gray-head, Pale Purple and Yellow Coneflower, Plains and Tickseed Coreopsis, Goat's Rue, Golden Alexanders, Gray Goldenrod, Indian Paintbrush, Slender Lespedeza, Obedient Plant, Partridge Pea, White and Purple Prairie Clover, Wild Quinine, and Sensitive Brier. Seeding Rate: 11 lbs/acre</i>
Prairie Patchwork Mix    \$7.00/oz \$73.00/lb These plants thrive in average soils; not too dry or too wet. This mix lends color to a landscape from May to October just as these same plants once added color to the vast expanses of prairie once covering the Midwest.	<i>Sky Blue Aster, White Beardtongue, Wild Bergamot, Common and Sweet Black-eyed Susan, Gray-head and Pale Purple Coneflower, Grand, Plains, and Tickseed Coreopsis, Gray and Showy Goldenrod, Indian Paintbrush, Roundhead Lespedeza, Partridge Pea, Prairie Parsley, Sampson Snakeroot, Sensitive Brier, and Slender Mtn. Mint. Seeding Rate: 11 lbs/acre</i>
Shadows & Sunbeams     \$7.00/oz \$73.00/lb Large park-like trees and an understory of native grasses and wildflowers define a savanna. This wildflower mix enjoys the paradox of sun and shade found in savannas and will do best in areas with at least 50% sunshine. It thrives in all but the wettest and driest soils.	<i>Sky Blue Aster, White Beardtongue, Black-eyed Susan, Pale Purple Coneflower, Plains and Tickseed Coreopsis, Goat's Rue, Gray Goldenrod, Lead Plant, Slender Lespedeza, New Jersey Tea, Purple Prairie Clover, Wild Quinine, Rattlesnake Master, Sampson's Snakeroot, Downy Skullcap, Slender Mtn. Mint, Ox-eye Sunflower, and Yellow Wingstem. Seeding Rate: 11 lbs/acre</i>
Butterfly & Hummingbird Mix     \$8.00/oz \$85.00/lb Pollinators need nectar sources throughout the growing season; this mix is comprised of bloom times spring through fall - at least 8 species per season. This beautiful mix also provides food sources for caterpillars. Plant alone or in drifts with other mixes in highly visible areas such as near the home or patio. This is our most diverse mix.	<i>Aromatic and Sky Blue Aster, White Beardtongue, Wild Bergamot, Black-eyed Susan, Pale Purple Coneflower, Grand, Plains, and Tickseed Coreopsis, Golden Alexanders, Gray and Showy Goldenrod, Curly Cup Gum Weed, Indian Paintbrush, Slender Lespedeza, Butterfly Milkweed, New Jersey Tea, Obedient Plant, Partridge Pea, Purple and White Prairie Clover, Rosin Weed, Royal Catchfly, Slender Mtn. Mint, and Tickseed Sunflower. Seeding Rate: 11 lbs/acre</i>
Companion Grass Mix <i>Dry, Mesic, or Shade</i>      \$4.00/oz \$18.00/lb This is an essential part of any planting because these non-aggressive prairie grasses discourage weeds by filling voids and provide support for the wildflowers. Because they are relatively short, these grasses don't distract from the flowers and also provide color in the winter landscape. For easy care, 25% to 50% of a wildflower planting should be grasses.	<i>Dry Mix – Ideal for very dry soils. Contents: Broomsedge, Splitbeard, Winter Bentgrass, and Sideoats Grama. Mesic Mix – Thrives in average soils. Contents: Broomsedge, Little Bluestem, Winter Bentgrass, and Sideoats Grama. Shade Mix - Suited to sites that receive direct sunlight at least 50% of the day. Contents: Virginia Wild Rye, Broomsedge, Purple Top, and Winter Bent Grass. Seeding Rate: 11 lbs/ac.</i>
